Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee Policy, Guidelines, and Standard Operating Procedures

Whistleblower Policy

306.1 Purpose

Emory University has an obligation under the Animal Welfare Act and the PHS to ensure that all animal research conducted at Emory facilities are carried out in a humane and appropriate fashion. Concerns related to the use of animals in research can be reported in confidence to the IACUC office or any Veterinarian (Division of Animal Resources or Yerkes National Primate Research Center) who will then forward these concerns to the IACUC office. Alternatively, compliance concerns can also be reported anonymously by calling the Emory Trust Line or accessing the Emory Trust Line Online.

No member of the Emory University community (faculty, staff, postdoctoral fellow or student) will be discriminated against or subject to reprisals for reporting possible violations of animal care standards.

306.2 Applicability

This policy applies to all Emory research related animal activities that fall under the IACUC's jurisdiction.
